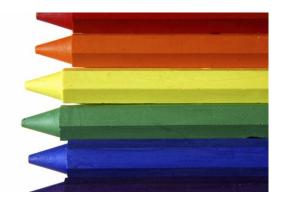

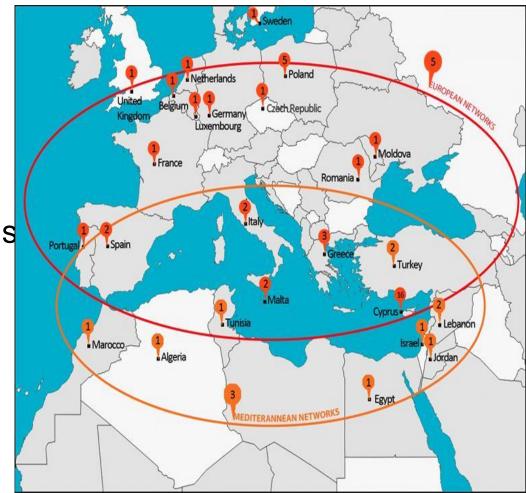
## **MMN Objectives**

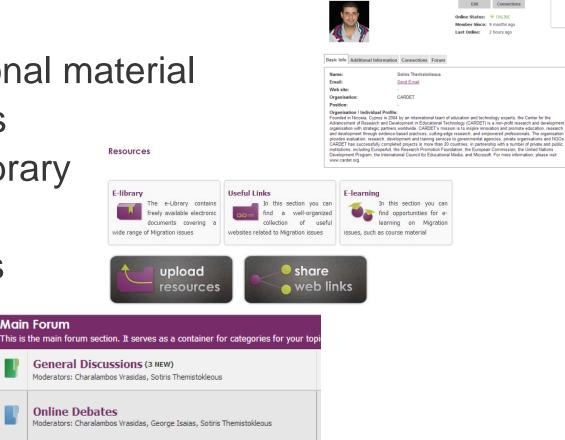
